Web-based survey on social networking site:

http://www.draugiem.lv (in English 'for friends')

2.6 million registered website users who mostly are Latvians

Survey was posted to all users who were located in the **UK**, **Ireland**, **Germany**, **Sweden** and **Norway** (IP addresses). Initially first selection question excluded those who are only visiting these countries.


Several query rounds (2010 – 2014)

Sample used in this study consists of **2,702** Latvians living in the top destination countries at the time of survey (2014).




Travel frequency to other countries








Relatives living in Latvia








Travel frequency of visitors from Latvia








Mean travel frequency by different migration time periods of respondents








Mean travel frequency by top destination countries








Travel frequency of visitors from Latvia by different migration time periods of respondents
